Peacemakers International has long had the reputation of being a ministry who specializes in reaching out to "the least of these." Although it is true that we have done this consistently since the mid 90's, we wanted to share the good news with you that our outreach efforts have tripled, or even quadrupled in recent months! Earlier in the winter, we began making more inroads with organizations in Detroit who service the homeless.

As we were picking up these people to come to our monthly outreaches, we realized that with many of them, a hunger was in place to come to Peacemakers more often.

We began to let these people know that if they would like, we will make the effort to come pick them up for our services. What a great change this has been! It is now not unusual for there to be 50-60 homeless people at our Sunday and Thursday services, besides others who show up from other cities. This has made for a great environment to impact even more lives! Many of these people come faithfully twice a week, and we have seen a good number of them either give their lives to Jesus, or re-dedicate themselves to the Lord. To God be the glory!
