From 2003-2011, we had a functioning women's home called the Mercy House. The Mercy House was a place for battered, abused, and addicted women to find safe refuge in. These women would attend Bible studies, church services, and receive plenty of one on one Christian care. In 2011 the women who were there went back to work, found apartments to stay in, and suddenly the house was empty...and so the "Mercy House" as a program for women went into hibernation. Fast forward to 2019 and there is a lot of interest in getting the Mercy House back up and running. The main thing at the moment is that we are working on finding the right location to have the women's program. The idea of building a new house is presently being evaluated by our board. We have recently had a couple small fundraisers to raise funds and awareness about our idea for the Mercy House.
