Hello to all of our friends out there! I hope you are enjoying this cooler weather as much as I am. We at Peacemakers are thankful to God for His provision over all these years, and we are also thankful for you and the blessing you have been. We do our best to be frugal and faithful with what God has given us. We operate out of a 1920's 4 story warehouse on Chene St. and use the older vans and busses we have to pick up people from homeless shelters who want to attend the services. We meet Sundays at 6 p.m. and Thursdays at 7 p.m. for service. During the week, there are many Bible studies for the men in the Jesus House, which is a men's discipleship program. It is very interesting to get to know these men that are usually homeless when we meet them, unemployed, possibly addicted... but if they are willing to submit to our one year discipleship

program, we are able to take them in. In the future, we plan on opening a house for women who also need a "hand up". We are open to the Lord's guidance with this because it first needs a location, and then proper leadership. So, what the Lord orders, He can most definitely provide! In closing, I want to again thank each of you for the part you've played to bring us this far. Some of you give monetarily, and some their time with their gifts and talents.
